Changes in commercial disclosure requirements in California and New York are expected to take effect in 2022 that will have a significant impact on the commercial equipment leasing and finance sector. The new regulations apply to all equipment financing transactions, except true leases, of less than \$500,000 in California and less than \$2.5 million in New York. New disclosure require-

ments have also been introduced in Connecticut. Mississippi, Missouri, New Jersey, North Carolina and Utah. ELFA has been fighting to exclude the equipment leasing and finance industry from these onerous disclosure laws since they were first introduced. This session will highlight the current status of all the Disclosure bills and focus attention on critical informational resources. ELFA has complied to assist and educate the industry on this topic.

Section 1071 has always been on the horizon, but the horizon is coming a lot faster now! Recent proposals from the CFPB have made this off-in-the-distance proposal one that needs to be taken into account in equipment finance companies' budget and planning processes today. Once this provision is implemented, it will dramatically change the process for equipment finance originations and increase compliance costs on an ongoing basis. This session will focus on what Executives need to be thinking about today to prepare their companies for compliance as early as 2024.
